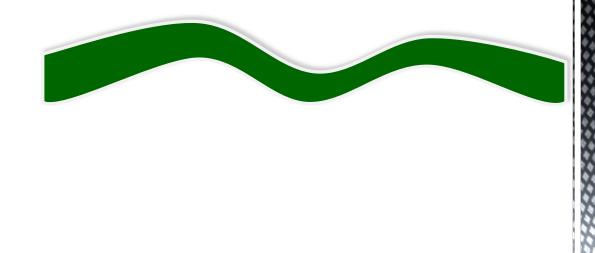

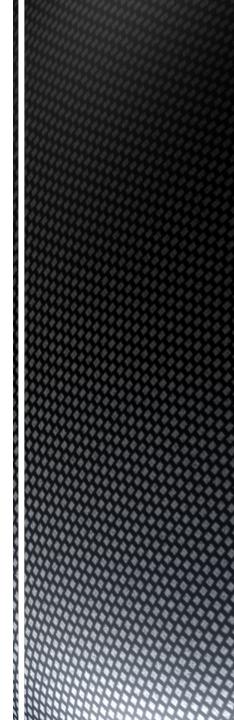


CollegeBoard Advanced Placement Program

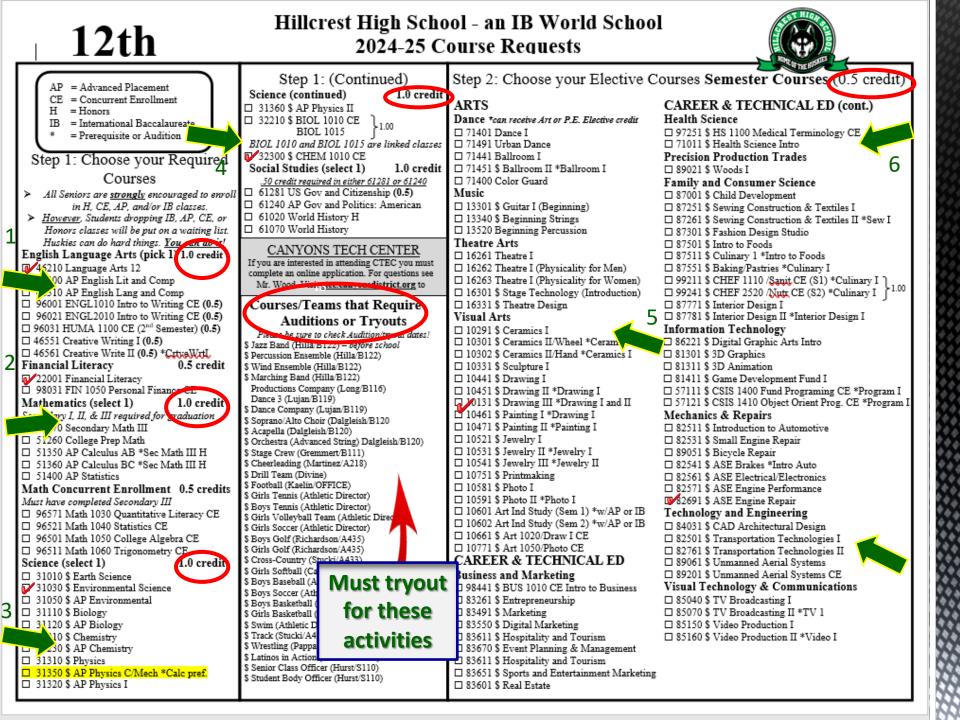

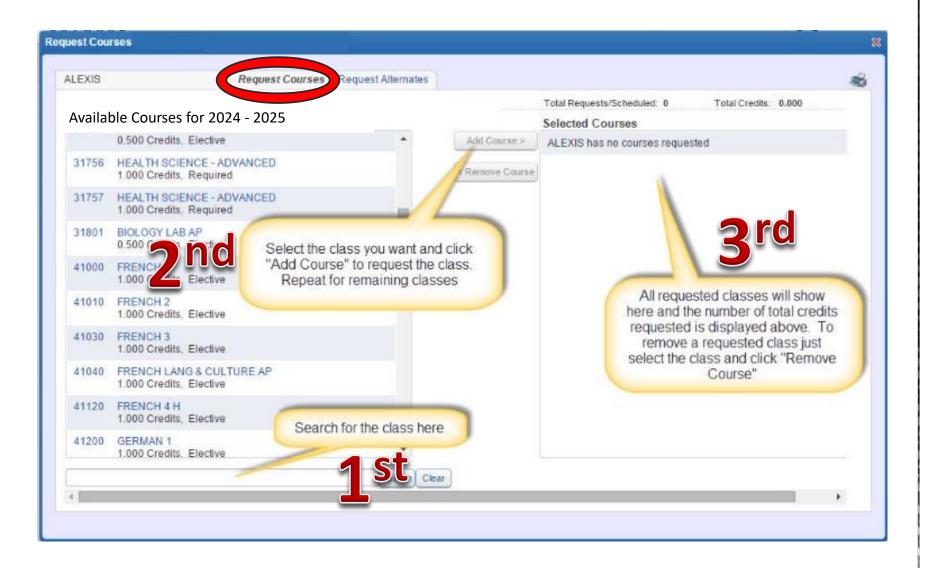
