Hillcrest High School Dance Guidelines

General Guidelines

- 1. School rules apply at all dances.
- 2. Tickets will be sold in advance of the dance and at the door. Dance fees are covered by fee waiver. Contact an administrator with questions.
- 3. Students must present their ticket and school ID to gain entrance into the dance.
- 4. NO bags or backpacks allowed.
- 5. NO outside containers, drinks, bottles, cans.
- 6. The school is not responsible for articles lost or stolen at a dance.
- 7. Shoes must always be worn.
- 8. No heels allowed on gym floors. Only tennis shoes allowed on gym floors.
- 9. Students are not permitted to leave the dance and return. Doors may be opened under the supervision of a chaperone to promote air circulation.
- 10. School authorities maintain the right to prohibit music that is not consistent with the mission of Canyons School District.
- 11. Students will be sent home for inappropriate dancing or behavior.
- 12. Any student who engages in fighting, harassment, or other disruptive behavior shall be immediately dealt with accordingly by the administration on duty. Ticket price will NOT be refunded if a student is asked to leave the dance.
- 13. Students are admitted as couples, at least one student must attend Hillcrest High School.
- 14. All students and guests must have a valid picture ID to be admitted to the dance.
- *If a HHS student doesn't have a picture ID, they can pull up their current class schedule on their phone or use their temporary ID for identification.
- 15. Students bringing a guest that doesn't attend HHS must fill out a guest form ONLINE prior to the dance. Guests must be in 9th, 10th, 11th, or 12th grade, no older than 18 years of age and no younger than 14 years of age. Guests must present a valid picture ID to enter the dance. Guests are expected to arrive at the dance and remain with their Hillcrest student host while attending the dance. Administration reserves the right to refuse entry to any guest for any reason.
- 16. Prohibited: Clothing that displays an insignia or sign which shows disrespect for any race, creed, color, or nationality. Clothing that displays obscene or suggestive phrases, or illegal behavior. Gang apparel and any other dress deemed inappropriate by the administration. Clothing, jewelry, or accessories that advertise or promote alcohol, tobacco, or illegal substances. Clothing or accessories that are disruptive or pose a safety hazard including masks or face coverings of any kind.
- 17. Any student on suspension may not participate in school dances (or other school activities).

Set Up/Clean Up

Coordinate with the assigned administrator and custodial staff for set up time.

Clean up needs to happen right after the dance ends.

Guest Form

Guest forms MUST be filled out online PRIOR to the dance starting. Check for cut off times for each dance!
