UTAH DIRECT PROGRAM

- Many Seniors have received "acceptance" letters from the University of Utah this is part of a new program this year, guaranteeing admission to rising Seniors.
- Unweighted 3.5 GPA or higher in Canyons District.
- Students still MUST apply in order to be accepted and be able to enroll.
- The QR Code on the letter takes the student to the U's Beehive Application.
- Once the U receives the student's application and transcripts, they will receive guaranteed admission.
- The priority deadline is **December 1, 2024**. In order to be considered for merit scholarships, students must meet that December 1 deadline.

BYU

- BYU's priority application deadline is **November 1, 2024.**
- Please get started on this application if you haven't already the application is lengthy and has several required supplemental materials as part of the application.

StudentAid.Gov Account Setup

To create a Federal Student Aid account, visit: studentaid.gov/fsa-id



What's needed to create a StudentAid.Gov account?

Account usernames and passwords are required for the student and each parent.

- 1. Name: Full legal name as it appears on your Social Security card.
- 2. Date of Birth
- 3. Social Security Number: Required for those with an SSN. Not required for parents without one.
- 4. Email: Must be verified. Use a non-school email. Students will need access to this email throughout college.
- 5. **Mobile Phone/Authenticator App**: Optional to download but recommended for login, account recovery, and enhanced security.

Who NEEDS to create a StudentAid.Gov Account?
☐ Students seeking financial aid.
Biological or adoptive parents of dependent students
(with or without a Social Security Number).
If parents are divorced or separated, only the parent who
provides the majority of financial support to the student
will need a StudentAid.Gov Account. If that parent is
remarried, the stepparent may need one, too.
☐ Student's spouse, if applicable.

Who should NOT create a StudentAid.Gov Account?

- Parents who already have a StudentAid.Gov Account (parents cannot create a new one).
- Students without a Social Security Number.

 Cannot file the FAFSA. Please consult a school counselor or college adviser for alternative ways to pay for college, scholarship opportunities, and info on HB 144.
- × Grandparents, foster parents, legal guardians
- × Siblings
- × Aunts, uncles, cousins, etc.

How do I know if my parents need to create an account? What if my parents aren't a part of my life? If students can answer YES to any of the following questions, they do NOT need parental accounts.

- Will you be 24 years of age or older as of Jan 2025, OR are you married but not separated or divorced?
- Do you have a child or another dependent to whom you provide the majority of financial support?
- Are you currently on active duty, OR are you a veteran of the U.S. Armed Forces?
- At any time since you turned 13, were you an orphan, in foster care, or a ward of the court?
- Are or were you ever a legally emancipated minor, as determined by a court?
- Do you have a court-ordered legal guardian who is not your biological or adoptive parent?
- Are you unaccompanied AND either homeless OR self-supporting and at risk of being homeless?
- Do you have an unusual circumstance that prevents you from contacting your parent(s)? Ask for more details.

Important Warning

 The StudentAid.Gov website times out if you're inactive for a short period. You must complete the setup in one session or start over.

Experiencing issues or already have an account and can't log in?

 If you have trouble or can't access your account, call Federal Student Aid at 1-800-433-3243.

Finished?

- Don't forget to save your backup code!
- Processing your identity may take 1-3 business days.
 During this time, you won't be able to transfer IRS tax information to the FAFSA form.

Keep your account information handy for the FAFSA each year. Take a picture or keep it in your wallet.

- Earn a 3.3 cumulative high school GPA
- Complete 3 advanced courses (see next question for more details about eligible courses)
- Complete 1 Advanced Placement (AP), International Baccalaureate (IB), or Concurrent Enrollment (CE) course in each of the core areas of high school graduation:
 - Math,
 - Science, and
 - Language Arts
- Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)
- Graduate from a Utah high school





Scholarship application opens: January

2, 2025

Priority deadline: January 27, 2025 Final deadline: March 21, 2025

How to Apply

Students must apply for the Opportunity Scholarship during their senior year of high school by completing the following steps.

- 1. Submit the Online Application: Fill out and submit the online scholarship application to be considered.
- 2. Complete the FAFSA: Make sure to submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). 2025 applicants must complete the 2025/26 FAFSA.
- 3. Meet the Deadlines: Both the online scholarship application and FAFSA must be submitted by the priority or final deadline.





REQUIREMENTS

- Be living in and attending a school in Utah.
- Be of Hispanic/Latino descent
- Minimum of 2.5 GPA and making satisfactory progress (as formally defined by the institution) toward the student's program objective (degree, diploma, or certificate).
- Must be a high school senior or undergraduate student.
- Available for students in or planning on attending a two-year or four-year college, a certificate program, or trade/vocational school.
- Have demonstrated involvement or leadership in school, community and/or other service organizations.
- All scholarship winners **MUST BE** present at SOMOS Gala (April 2025) to receive scholarship award.
- First-generation, immigrant, undocumented, and international students are encouraged to apply.

Submit a complete application by **December 7th, 2024 at 11:59 P.M.**

How to Apply

- A copy of your most recent unofficial high school or college transcript
- A copy of your most updated resume
- One letter of recommendation (someone who can describe your academic, leadership, and personal qualifications, for example your counselor, teacher, employer, or mentor). We have provided an optional letter of recommendation template for you to use with suggestions on what your recommender can share.

For Utah Scholarship

The For Utah Scholarship program ensures **four years** of tuition and fees are covered by grant and scholarship assistance for Utah residents who are eligible for the Pell Grant.

WHO QUALIFIES:

- Utah resident
- First-time freshmen
- High school GPA of 3.2 or above
- Annual completion of the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and confirmed Pell Grant eligibility



How to Apply:

- Prospective students must first submit your **University of Utah application** and any supporting documents by the **December 1** deadline.
- Students hoping to receive the For Utah scholarship must complete the <u>Net Price</u>
 <u>Calculator</u> and submit their information to the university by clicking "Save Estimate".
- Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) by the February 1
 priority deadline in order to know by March 1 whether you are a For Utah Scholarship
 finalist.
- Wait to be admitted and receive your letter of acceptance.
- The U will contact you regarding potential eligibility for the scholarship.
- Complete enrollment at the University of Utah.
- Attend classes and begin your education.




